

15TH ANNUAL REGIONAL JURIED EXHIBITION: CONSTRUCTED TRUTH

Saturday, June 29, 2013 to Saturday, August 10, 2013



Curated by **Yaël Filipovic**, *Constructed Truth* is Modern Fuel's 15th Annual Regional Juried Members' Exhibition and will be presented at Modern Fuel from June 29th to August 10th, 2013. Works by the six artists in this year's exhibition include **Dave Gordon**, **Kasia Knap**, **Matt Kyba**, **Maria Flawia Litwin**, **Michelle MacKinnon** and **Anna Soper**, and together reflect the excellence of a range of artistic practices of our members. An opening reception with the artists and curator in attendance will be held **Saturday June 29th at 7pm**.

Yaël Filipovic currently works at the Canadian Centre for Architecture in Montreal, and holds an MA in Museum Studies from the University of Toronto and a BA in Art History and Education from McGill University (Montreal). Her work combines her interest in research, art, activism and pedagogy. Past curatorial projects include *Neighbour to Neighbour: Living Libraries* (Foreman Art Gallery, 2011), *ArtiFACTS of Belief* (University of Toronto Art Centre, 2010), and *Soliloquies: Reflections of Solitude* (Two Rivers Gallery, 2008). Interested in the use of public space, her public interventions have taken place in both Toronto and Montreal. From May 2010 to August 2012, she was the Curator, Education and Cultural Action at the Foreman Art Gallery of Bishop's University in Sherbrooke, Quebec developing their Community Art Laboratory.
